OUR SOLUTION

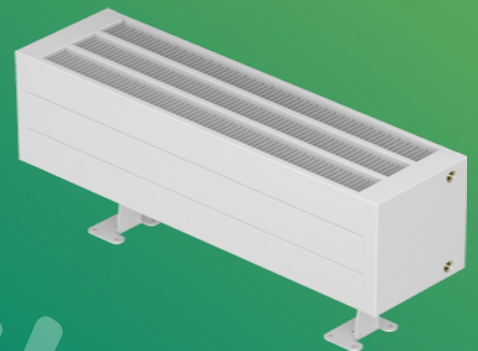
